Program 2016:

Thu:	Arrivals of the teams, registration and welcome party

Format 2016:

Age of players:	All players must be 35 and over.
Maximum teams:	Event is limited to 12 teams (up to 8 Under 50s and 4 Over 50s)
Match rules:	EVRA Veteran Laws of the Game (Modified IRB Laws), details on www.evrugbya.org - under EVRA Festivals / Veteran Game Laws

Fees and registration 2016:

- Team registrations: By March 31st including a €100 non-refundable deposit/team
- Player registrations: By April 30th, including €95/person
(fee covering welcome package, Thursday welcome party and the Saturday farewell banquet)

Since the number of teams is limited we recommend teams register as early as possible.
